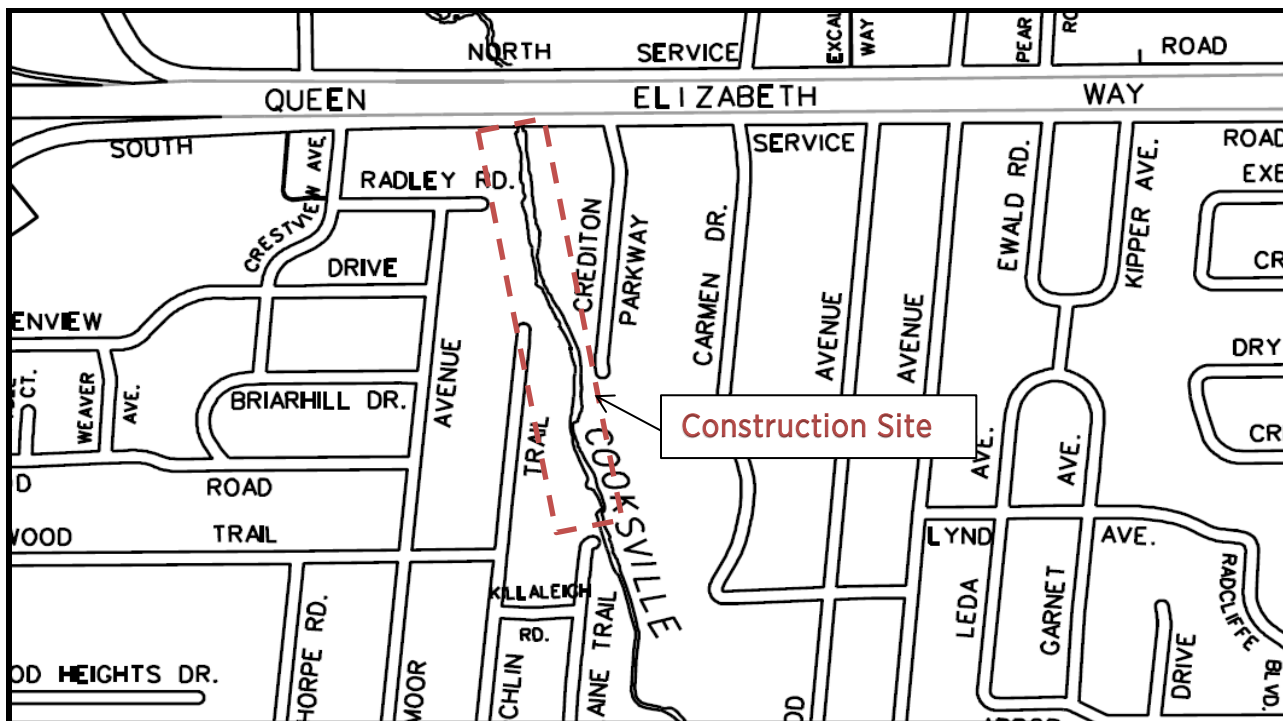


Cooksville Creek Erosion Control Project

Construction Work: On or after **January 4 to June 30, 2021**

Scope of Work

The purpose of this project is to perform stream restoration and erosion protection work to Cooksville Creek from south of Queen Elizabeth Way to Elaine Trail. The rebuilding of the armour stone retaining wall, grading and landscaping will also be completed as part of this project.



COVID-19 Update: Taking Steps to Stop the Spread

The construction project that will be taking place is an essential service under the recently enacted Ontario Regulation 82/20 because it involves the repair and maintenance of the City's infrastructure. The City's Contractor is required to carry out all construction activities in accordance with all applicable laws, including the *Occupational Health and Safety Act* (and regulations) and the advice, recommendations and instructions of public health officials. These recommendations include training of all employees, contractors and trades on COVID-19 policies, maintaining physical distancing of 2 metres, providing on-site sanitation, and tracking and monitoring of workers and site visitors. The City will closely monitor and work with the Contractor to ensure complete adherence to all COVID-19 regulations and policies. The Province has also advised that they will be increasing the number of Ministry of Labour Inspectors to ensure that essential businesses are complying with the health and safety requirements.

What to Expect During Construction

Impacts	There will be some construction related dust, noise and traffic delays. The City will make every effort to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience and cooperation.	
Work Hours	Work will occur between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.	
Traffic and Pedestrians	Roads	No Road closure during construction.
	Sidewalks / Multi-Use Trail	No impact during construction.
Transit Service	No impact during construction.	
Parking	No impact during construction.	
Restoration Works	The construction site will be restored with sod after construction has been completed.	
Utility Disruptions	Temporary disruptions to utilities (i.e. gas, hydro, water, telecommunications and cable TV) may be experienced. Every effort will be made to promptly restore service.
