# GO Expansion Program: Virtual Open House November 27 to December 11, 2020

#### Join us for the third round of Public Consultation!

Metrolinx will be hosting a virtual open house from November 27 to December 11, 2020, for six elements as part of the GO Expansion program:

- New Track and Facilities Transit Project Assessment Process (TPAP);
- Scarborough Junction Grade Separation TPAP;
- Stouffville Rail Corridor Grade Separations TPAP;
- Network-Wide Structures Project (Addendum to the Barrie Rail Corridor Expansion TPAP 2017);
- Addendum to the GO Rail Network Electrification TPAP 2017; and
- Union Station Trainshed Heritage Conservation.


In Round 3, we are presenting our draft Environmental Project Report findings, including design updates to previously presented infrastructure; the latest environmental study results for the proposed new infrastructure along with the updates on operational noise, vibration and air quality studies; and improvements to the Union Station Trainshed.

### **GO Expansion Program Overview**

Metrolinx is building a transit service that will transform the region through the GO Expansion program. More than a rush hour commuter service, GO will offer more service with faster trains and seamless connections to a regional rapid transit network. Future electrified service will also mean more efficient, quieter, faster and more reliable trains.

Proposed new infrastructure includes new track and facilities (such as layover facilities, storage yards, etc.) throughout the network and a number of grade separations (places where the rail network is separated from the road network or other rail lines). We also have updates to operational noise, vibration, and air quality studies. These new elements represent work that will enable two-way all-day GO rail service.
