Reminder: Any Time is Train Time

Your safety is our top priority. We want to take a moment to remind our community that any time is train time, in any direction. GO trains are not the only trains that use our rail corridors, which makes it impossible for residents to know for sure when the next train might come along the corridor.

There has been an increase in illegal trespassing on the GO rail corridor at the Credit River Bridge over the past few weekends and Metrolinx takes this very seriously. Accessing the corridor is not only extremely dangerous for the trespassers themselves, but also for those on the train. While it may look harmless or even fun, accessing, climbing, and jumping off rail bridges are considered potentially life-threatening emergencies. Please treat them like as such.

Transit Safety will be present around the corridor as much as possible over the next few weeks. Metrolinx will also shortly be securing the property around the Bridge to deter those trying to trespass onto the rail corridor.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU?

Starting this summer, workers will begin removing and deposing of existing fencing materials, on both the east and west side of the Credit River Bridge. In some areas, there is vegetation surrounding and growing within the existing fence which will ultimately need to be removed to install the new, higher fencing on the property line. Certified arborists will be working in the area to preform tree trimming/removals along Metrolinx property line for the purpose of the new fencing installation.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Work will take place on both the east and west sides of the Credit River Bridge, extending from Stavebank Rd to Mississauga Rd.
- The project will take approximately six (6) months to complete
- You can expect to see crews working on Metrolinx lands, or within the municipal right-of-way.
- While we do our best to complete work during weekdays, some weekend or overnight work may be required.
