Individuals Who Received Their First Dose of an mRNA Vaccine before May 9 are Eligible to Receive Shorten Second Dose

Starting Monday, June 14, individuals who received their first dose of an mRNA vaccine before May 9 are eligible to receive their second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine at a shortened interval in several Public Health Units across Ontario, including Peel. Second Doses Information Based on Vaccine Type

If residents received AstraZeneca as their first dose:

- **Option 1:** Receive AstraZeneca vaccine for second dose, 12 weeks after first through [pharmacies or primary care providers](#).
- **Option 2:** Receive mRNA vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna) for second dose, 12 weeks after first dose
- **Eligibility:** Received first dose 12 weeks ago or longer

If residents received Pfizer or Moderna as their first dose:


- Recommended to receive the same vaccine for second dose, at least 28 days after first dose. If original vaccine is not available, it may interchange between Pfizer or Moderna.
- **Eligibility:** 70+, select health conditions, high-risk healthcare workers, residents of congregate settings for seniors, and individuals who received their first dose before May 9 (starting June 14).

Update on Shortened Second Dose for Youth


After Sunday, June 27, youth will be able to rebook their second dose appointment through the provincial booking system at a shortened interval of 8 to 10 weeks to allow them to get their second dose by August 22, based on age and reason for immunization.
