Eligible workers in licensed child care settings will receive a letter from their employer. This letter must be available at the point of booking and taken to the vaccination appointment.

As of May 3, persons 18 years of age or older living in hot spots are eligible to book a vaccine appointment. Additionally, this week all persons 50 years or older living in Peel will become eligible.
