### What's New

#### Adults 18+ Across Peel

As of Thursday, May 6, all 11 mass vaccine clinics in Peel region will accept bookings for individuals who live in Peel and are 18 years of age and older. This is not a provincial announcement, but a step being taken by Peel Public Health to support and offer protection for all Peel residents who live in the region with the highest COVID-19 cases in the province.

<b>Educators and Workers in Licensed Child Care Settings</b>	 	 All educators and workers in licensed child care settings who live or work in Peel hot spots must call the Province's COVID-19 vaccine call centre ( <b>1-833-943-3900</b> ) to book an appointment. Eligible workers in licensed child care settings will receive a letter from their employer. This letter must be available at the point of booking and taken to the vaccination appointment.
<b>Adults 40+</b>		Find the closest pharmacy on the <a href="#">Province's registration system</a> . (AstraZeneca vaccine only). <a href="#">24/7 pharmacies</a>
